

Important Information About Outpatient Services and Partial Hospitalization Visitor Guidelines

The safety and well-being of our patients, visitors and staff is our number one priority. Please note the following policy revisions regarding individuals and caretakers coming to UBHC sites for their respective appointments and/or programs.

NO VISITORS WILL BE ALLOWED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

in Rutgers University Behavioral Health Care facilities.

Current Policy Is As Follows:

- Adult Outpatient and Partial Hospitalization Appointments: A caretaker will be allowed to accompany a consumer and will need to respond to screening questions.
- Adult EISS Appointments: A caretaker will be allowed to accompany a consumer and will need to respond to screening questions.
- **Child/Adolescent Outpatient and Partial Hospitalization Appointments: ONE** parent or legal guardian may be present for appointments and will need to respond to screening questions.
- **Child Crisis Clinic: ONE** parent or legal guardian may be present for appointments and will need to respond to screening questions.

PLEASE NOTE: Extenuating circumstances will be considered based on the best interest and needs of the individual patient.

Approved guests will be screened for the following and may <u>not</u> be allowed to visit or stay based on:

- International travel, in the last 14 days
- Direct Contact with individuals with known COVID19
- Cold or flu-like symptoms including fever, shortness of breath and cough

All visitors should wash their hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer before and after visiting.
