## COMMUNITY EDUCATION

Activities such as workshops, webinars, assemblies, and training. This includes linkage to community resources.

- Students in grades Pre-K 12, families and school staff
- Virtual or in-person



Evidence-based prevention services, typically delivered in classroom settings.

- Students in grades 6-12, families and school staff
- Schools request services through the NJ4S portal
- Schools may be connected to existing programs implemented within the community

## BRIEF COUNSELING

Brief counseling for students in grades 6 – 12 provided by licensed clinicians.

- Services provided in-person or via telehealth
- Clinicians are also available for consultation with school staff and family members
- Schools request services through the NJ4S portal

New Jersey Statewide Student Support Services (NJ4S) is a program funded by the Department of Children and Families located at Rutgers University Behavioral Health Care providing an array of wellness services to support students, parents/caregivers, and support staff in Middlesex county.
